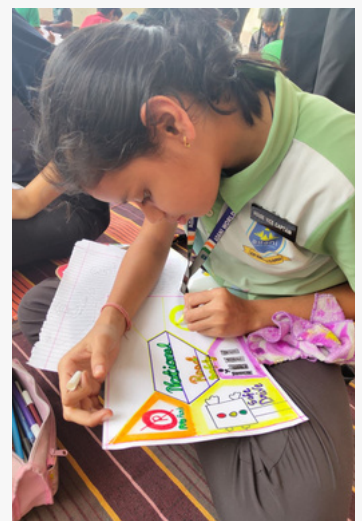
The activity helped students enhance their writing skills while understanding the importance of meaningful human relationships in today’s digital era.
